

Tumalo Day Camp: Volunteer Counselor

Job Description: Facilitate and help plan outdoor adventures, fun activities, crafts, games, and songs for a group of similarly-aged kids at a five day session of Tumalo Day Camp.

Details:

- There are two 5-day sessions of day camp. Each session, counselors are assigned a group of 8-10 boys and girls who are grouped by grade: PreK through 8th. The counselor is also assigned a Counselor in Training who will be the teen assistant.
- Each day of camp has a spirit theme (ie: Crazy hair, Backwards etc.)
- Under the guidance of the Camp Director, Counselors will follow a set curriculum teaching outdoor skills, arts and crafts, games, hikes, outdoor cooking, camping skills and more. Additionally, counselors are encouraged to bring their own skill set and share with the campers!
- Counselors leading 4th, 5th, 6th will go on a one-night overnighter with their group at Tumalo State Park campgrounds. 7th grade groups camp for 2 nights.
- There is a nurse on site at all times
- This camp is entirely run by volunteers, we couldn't do it without YOU!
- Funds are provided for supplies, parking passes provided too.
- **Great for someone looking for experience but can't dedicate an entire summer**
- Volunteer camp counselors send their kids to camp for FREE!

Qualifications: All volunteers must pass a background check and go through training

Training: Sunday, June 14th. 10am-3pm at Tumalo State Park. Lunch provided.
