Organization Background:

[Camp Fire Central Oregon](#) offers a variety of year-round, co-ed enrichment opportunities that empower youth, staff and volunteers to discover their sparks, build confidence, and be actively thriving contributors in their communities. In Central Oregon since 1916, Camp Fire intentionally creates a welcoming environment that is fun, inclusive, and supported by dynamic adult mentors.

Join a community of passionate educators who work hard to make a positive impact on the community and provide opportunities for local youth to find their sparks and thrive. At Camp Fire, we strive to create an environment where each youth and staff member has a sense of belonging, opportunities to share passions, and a place to thrive.

Program and Position Overview:

Camp Fire is seeking an enthusiastic and caring youth worker to help develop and implement our new full day program at Three Rivers School to support working families during Comprehensive Distance Learning (CDL). Camp Fire program staff are invaluable members of our team who serve as role models, motivators, educators, caregivers and spark champions. As part of a small and dynamic team of 3, program staff at our Three Rivers location will assist a cohort of 20 youth in 1st through 5th grade in managing their online school schedule, while also offering enrichment activities and subscribing to Camp Fire's intentional support for social and emotional development.

Program staff will work closely with the program manager to design the schedule, plan and implement curricula, and contribute ideas to build a fun, confidence building experience for youth. Staff will build community within the group, supervise distance learning, lead games and activities, and manage the physical and emotional safety of all participants.

Schedule:

This is a 40 hour per week, temporary position. Monday-Friday, 7:30 am -4:30 pm

Position duration: ~September 15- October 23rd (likely to be extended)

Program Start: September 21st

(There may be additional contract, full or part time opportunities with Camp Fire.)

Qualifications:

The ideal candidate is enthusiastic, fun-loving, patient, relationship-oriented, and genuinely cares about the well-being and development of youth and other staff. They are also safety-minded, organized, detail-oriented, and able to communicate ideas and needs effectively.

Prior experience in the youth development field is essential. Some higher education, equivalent experience or familiarity with best practices in teaching, group management, social-emotional learning, and trauma informed care is preferred. A commitment to equity and inclusion is a must.

Camp Fire recognizes the value of skills and knowledge gained outside of formal higher education and paid employment. Applicants who do not meet the minimum qualifications but present other qualifications or experience equivalent to those required, or demonstrate a strong desire to learn and gain job skills in the youth development, will be considered and are encouraged to apply.

A first aid/CPR certification is required by the time the position begins or soon thereafter.
